E, 6a



Road only for motor vehicles. Used on the continent and in the UK but it applies to different types of roads. (Continent it means access to a secondary road while in UK it means access to a motorway meaning that the speed limits are different)

E, 1a



Used on motorways Compulsory minimum speed limits, there is no speed limit on the third lane. (not used in NL but the law says you must drive at minimum 70 km/h)

E,3b



Indicates one way street on which you cannot drive the other way (words can be included in the sign)

E,13a



Hospital sign not used in the German traffic Regulation

H,8



A sign that should be used only in addition to another danger warning sign or priority sign. Sometimes it is used by itself, not recognised in Italy and Spain.
